Dodgy Deals Report

JDC has a new report out on the Government's Export Credit Guarantee Department (ECGD) called 'The Department for Dodgy Deals: Ending the UK's support for toxic debt'.

"[The ECGD] helps exporters to invest in 'high risk' projects or areas of the world by providing a form of insurance. (.....) Today the ECGD is the biggest holder of Third World debt owed to the British government. (.....) Much of this debt is deeply unjust, based on loans that harmed the people or the environment of the country in which the projects took place."

JDC has set out a series of recommendations for the ECGD, and is calling for it to be transformed into a socially responsible department which supports human rights and sustainable development.

This report is an excellent resource for campaigners, beginning with the basics of how the ECGD works and outlining case studies in Indonesia, Kenya, India and Lesotho. You can obtain a copy from the national JDC website, or from John Nightingale (see contact details below).
